ALLAN SCALLY

The Allan Scally Memorial Race is run to commemorate Allan Scally, a coach and masseur at Shettleston Harriers and a long time servant of the Scottish Amateur Athletic Association both as a race starter and a team manager.

Allan's own career as a professional athlete, competing as "Allan Scally of Broomhouse", excluded him from joining an amateur athletics club, so although Allan spent thirty-five years assisting Shettleston Harriers he was never a member of the club. His running career spanned the period from 1925 to 1935 in which he won the World's professional ten miles title and the then famous Powderhall Marathon title (a ten mile track race) a record five times. This period coincided with 'the depression' of the late twenties and early thirties and many people in the mining community of Broomhouse where Allan lived were thankful for the money generated by Allan's ability as a professional athlete to help fund the soup kitchens.

It was a great regret to Allan that he never wore the famous blue and gold vest of Shettleston Harriers, so as he considered his own running career to be over, he poured all his energy and experience into coaching and played a key role in the great success achieved by the club in the late 1940's and the early 1950's.

By then Allan had moved house to Baillieston and spent a lot of his time encouraging the youth of the area to take part in athletics by organising training and meetings, so it is fitting that the memorial race takes place in the area in which Allan devoted much of his time promoting athletics and a fitting tribute that so many athletes support the race each year. The Allan Scally Trophy, presented to the winning team, has become one of the most prized awards in Scottish Road Racing.

The Allan Scally Race History

The first Allan Scally Race was run in 1969, the trail ran round Baillieston, Garrowhill, Mount Vernon, Greenfield and along the Edinburgh Road back to Baillieston. From 1969 until 2008 the race was run over the same trail albeit from different starting points..

Over the years many of Scotland's greatest endurance runners have run over the course with Nat Muir setting the course record of 21:26 in 1985. The ladies course record of 25:16 was set by Hayley Haining in 2000.

The team course record of 89:18 was set by Shettleston Harriers in 1995, the only team ever to break 90 minutes on this course. Individually all the team members ran fast enough to rank inside the fastest listed times of 22:30, the team members were :- Adrian Callan 22:18, John Mackay 22:30, Billy Coyle 22:15 and Graeme Wight 22:15.
